

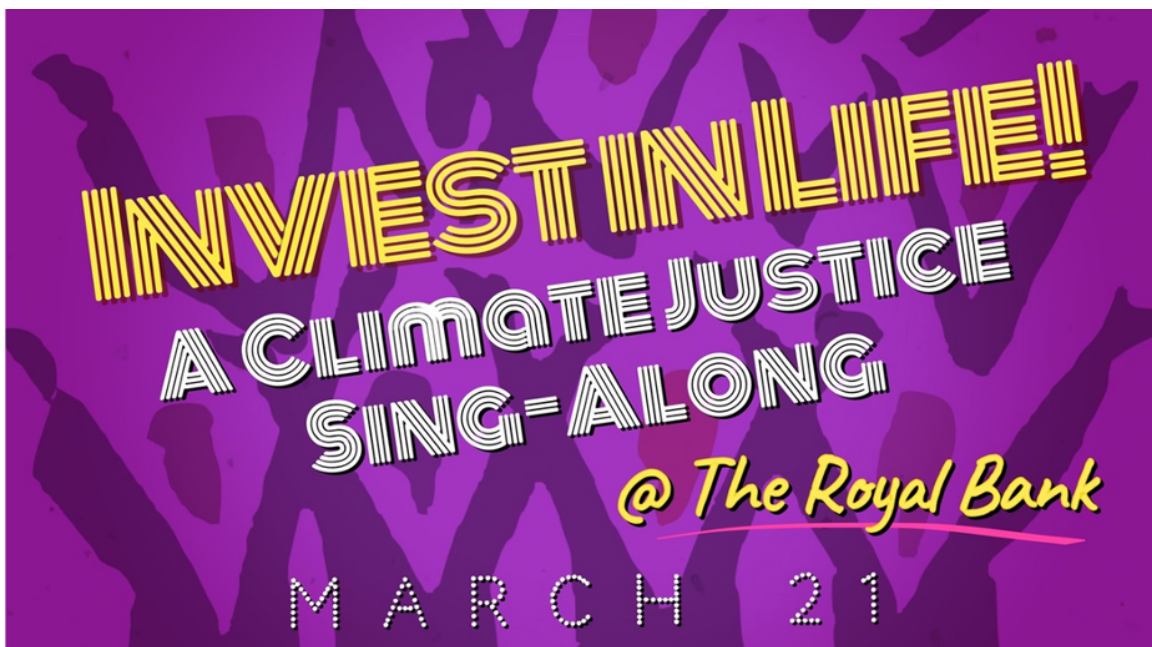

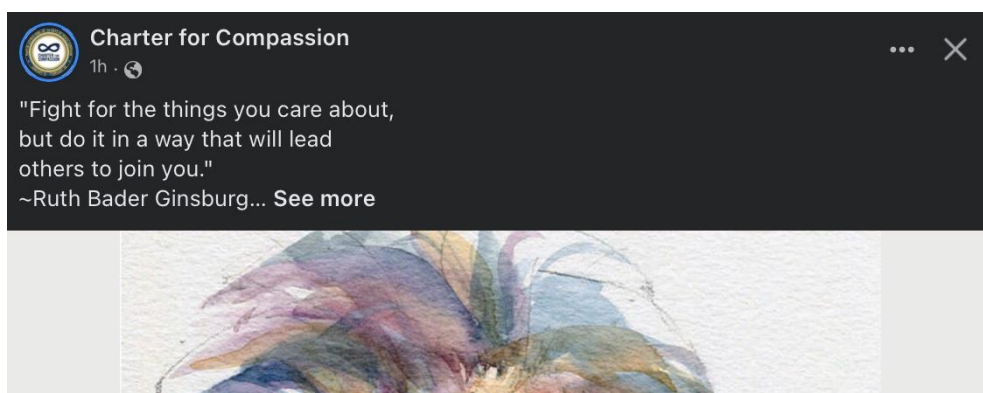


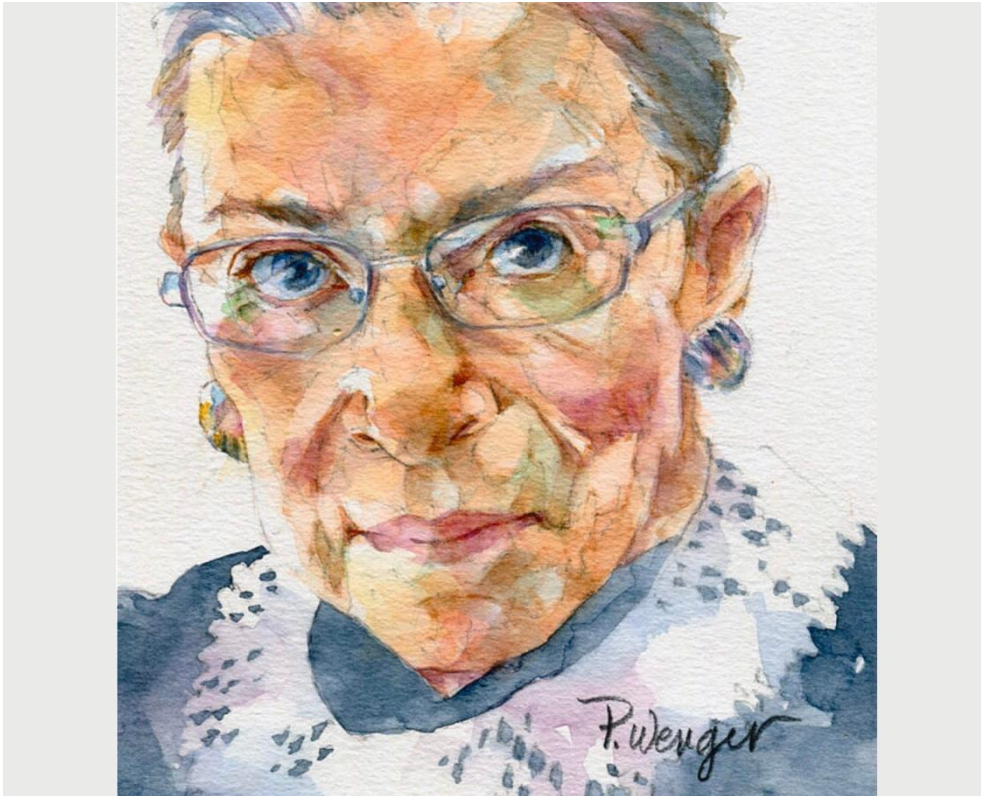
Sing for climate justice!

From Hosha-Na to Hosannah: Sukkot in both the Jewish and Christian Traditions

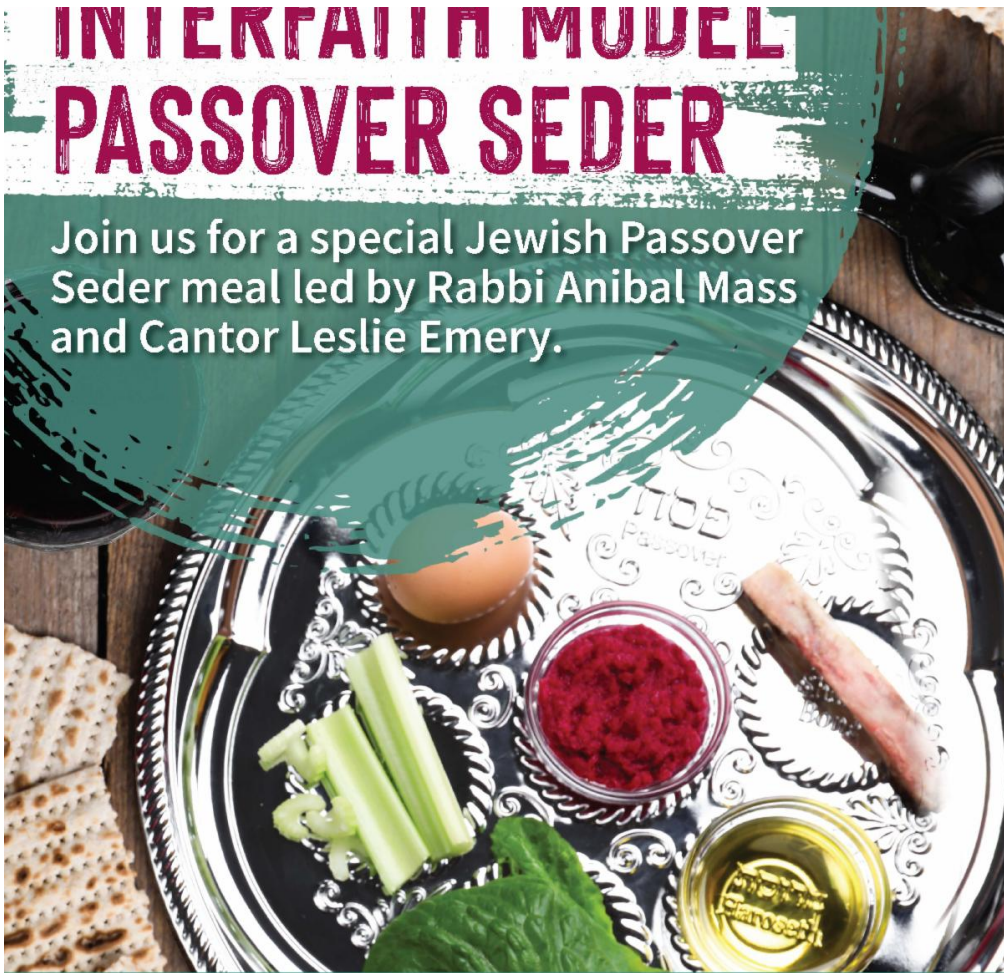
The CCCJ and Beth Tzedec Congregation invite everyone to join us for an intriguing program by Rabbi Cantor Russ.
