BUDDHISM 101

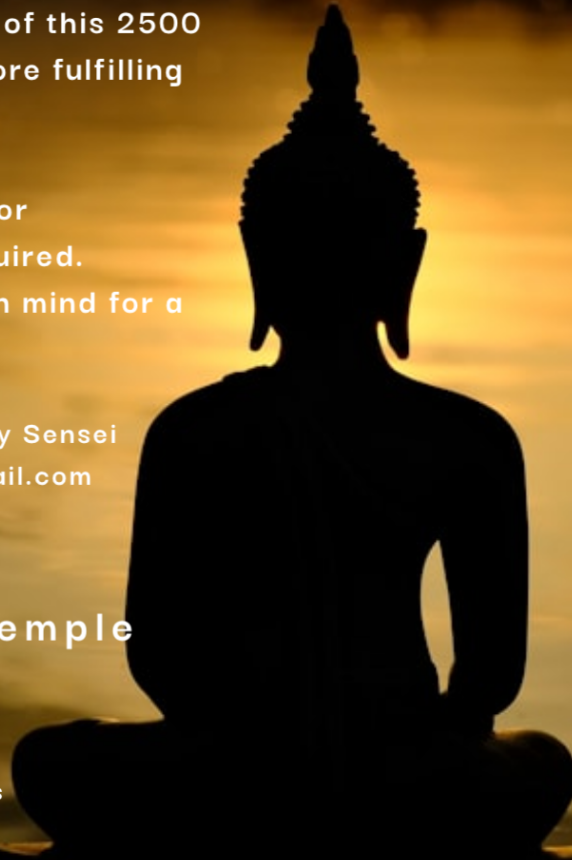
Learn the basics of Buddhism and explore many of the ideas and thoughts of this 2500 year-old approach to living a more fulfilling and happier life.

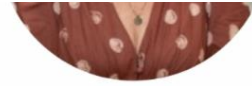
