# Lessons on dying well from the father of palliative care

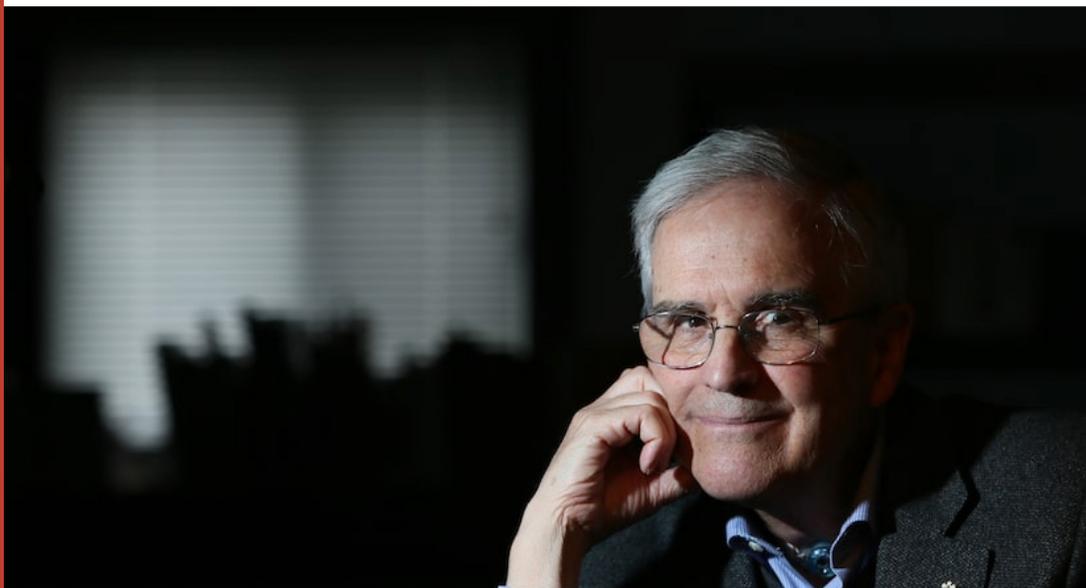
